Pastor's Profile

Geoffrey Isambo

Pastors in rural Africa are bi-vocational - they support their families and ministries through their own shambas (farms) and selling to the local markets, while others have retail businesses. Time and resources for study are limited and there are few opportunities to further their studies, or to build a library.

This is where the Krapf Project can help. Alongside providing resources, it is important for us to build relationships with these men, to get to know them and their families and to support and encourage them in the ministry. These are some of the men we work with.



This is pastor Geoffrey Isambo, a pastor and church planter in the Bungoma region in Western Kenya. Geoffrey and his wife have seven children, three daughters and four sons-all still at school. In May 2024, Geoffrey and his family moved into Bungoma to plant a church. He is partly supported by his sending church and by a local missionary organisation for teaching Bible to the staff.

I spoke Geoffrey for the first time back in December, although we have corresponded over this past two years on the WhatsApp groups, and he regularly engaged with the daily commentary.

Responding to the workshops in December 2024, Geoffrey said; "It has taught us how we can manage the Scriptures and bring out the simplicity of how we can bring the Word of God, particularly, ... in knowing how the typology of Christ is being revealed in the Bible."

Geoffrey asks for prayer

1. Pray for materials like good books on theology, particularly sermon preparation and hermeneutics.
2. We also pray that some can be touched to come and teach these people more biblical truth.
3. That God will help us to be faithful on his Word.
4. Lastly pray for me and the family to endure challenges [of the move] at this time in the new church plant.
