Pastor's Profile

Laban Ndungu Kamau

Pastors in rural Africa are bi-vocational - they support their families and ministries through their own shambas (farms) and selling to the local markets, while others have retail businesses. Time and resources for study are limited and there are few opportunities to further their studies, or to build a library.

This is where the Krapf Project can help. Alongside providing resources, it is important for us to build relationships with these men, to get to know them and their families and to support and encourage them in the ministry. These are some of the men we work with.

This is pastor Laban Ndungu Kamau. He is married to Nancy, and they have four boys; two in high school, one in primary and one in the family business.

Laban supports his family and ministry through his business, a hardware store in Mtwapa town, a busy market town about forty minutes north of Mombasa. Laban was in Bible college (2014-2018), when he realized that his pastor, like many men in the denomination, was not preaching the Bible, but "bending the word to suit himself." He continued, "I was in danger of becoming like him."

In 2022 then, Laban left his church and planted *Biblical Life Christian Fellowship* in Mtwapa. It's a small rural congregation consisting of about 70 people, which includes 30 children.

They began to build in March 2024, but the building is not yet finished. They need to raise funds for Sunday School rooms. Laban has attended the Krapf Project workshops and continues to benefit from our resources. He has a desire to study the Word, and to help the Krapf Project to get resources for pastors in his area.



Laban asks for Prayer:

- Pray for finances to finish the church building and to build Sunday school facilities.
- Pray for God's grace to preach the Word of God amid the prevailing fake versions of gospel, particularly the Prosperity Gospel and the African Traditional (indigenous) Religions.
- Pray for Laban's family, his two oldest boys are in boarding school and are struggling with school.
