Pastors in rural Africa are bi-vocational - they support their families and ministries through their own shambas (farms) and selling to the local markets, while others have retail businesses. Time and resources for study are limited and there are few opportunities to further their studies, or to build a library.

This is where the Krapf Project can help. Alongside providing resources, it is important for us to build relationships with these men, to get to know them and their families and to support and encourage them in the ministry. These are some of the men we work with.



This is pastor Lesantan Lepatoye. He is married to Irene, and they have been blessed with four daughters: Melan 12, Melissa 10, Melinda 8 and Megan 1 year and 9 months.

Lesantan and his family live in a very remote area of northern Kenya, and like most pastors in rural parts of Kenya, he supports his family with small scale farming.

For over eight years, Lesantan has been serving in an African Inland Church (AIC) in Ngurunit, in the Marsabit region. It is his goal that the Church will become increasingly a "Bible-centred church."

Lesantan has a church plant six kilometres from his church, currently meeting under a tree. Lesantan has been at a few of our Krapf Academy workshops. He is a good friend and supporter of the Krapf Project.

- Pray for all the leaders, elders, women, youth and the Sunday school.
- Pray for a revival in our church, for love and spiritual growth.
- We have the Soma pastor's training program, with Simeon trust, for raising biblical leaders.
- Pray for me. Sometimes I feel that I am not spending enough time on ministry because I must be distracted by working here and there to provide for my family. Ministry requires full-time.
