Paul Zadok

Pastors in rural Africa are bi-vocational - they support their families and ministries through their own shambas (farms) and selling to the local markets, while others have retail businesses. Time and resources for study are limited and there are few opportunities to further their studies, or to build a library.

This is where the Krapf Project can help. Alongside providing resources, it is important for us to build relationships with these men, to get to know them and their families and to support and encourage them in the ministry. These are some of the men we work with.

This is pastor Paul Zadok. He is married to Edner Ruth and they have four children, two boys and two girls. Paul supports his family with small scale farming.

Paul came to understand and appreciate the Doctrines of Grace and the great need for expository preaching in 2017, as we celebrated the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. Since then, he has taken courses with Mukhanyo Theological College, and during COVID he planted Community Transformation Church in Busia County, rural western Kenya.



Paul supports the Krapf Project on the ground by helping with distribution and organising the workshops. He has a passion for expository preaching and has travelled across the country to attend our workshops. He helps train pastors and church leaders in his area of Western Kenya in weekly classes with the help of Ekklesia Afrika.
